70 MPs & Senators Call for Pornhub Criminal Investigation

Press Release Mon, 15 Mar 2021 Today seventy members of parliament and senators from all eight political parties in Canada sent a letter to the head of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Brenda Lucki, calling for a full criminal investigation into Pornhub and its parent company MindGeek effectively based out of Montreal for breaking laws on the distribution and non-reporting of child pornography (CSAM). The letter from parliamentarians came shortly after a similar letter from 525 NGOs and 104 survivors from 65 countries calling for the same.

Both letters are attached.

Recently the Canadian Parliament's Ethics Committee has undertaken an investigation into Pornhub. The committee heard from multiple survivors of child abuse, rape and assault who were victimized on the site. The committee also uncovered the fact that according to the testimony of the RCMP and the heads of the leading child protection agencies in North America, Mind Geek has reported zero instances of known child sexual abuse material from 2008 to late 2020 to any relevant agency. Non-reporting of CSAM to the RCMP is illegal in Canada.
